

Summer Study Abroad in NYC

Program Overview

Summer Study Abroad in New York City at St. John's University is a multi-faceted, full-service program that balances traditional academic classroom experiences with less conventional learning outside of the classroom, through interactions with student guides. These guides introduce participants to some of the many historical and cultural sites and events available in New York City, providing opportunities for cultural exchange and language practice.

St. John's is a global, metropolitan university with campuses in New York City, Rome and Paris. It offers more than 100 undergraduate and graduate majors to a multinational and multiethnic student population. Our Queens campus is located in one of the most diverse places in the world—recently named a top travel destination by Lonely Planet—and provides many opportunities for encountering the rich, varied tapestry of American culture.



Coursework and Format

Monday-Thursday mornings, students attend PHS 3509: Introduction to Pharmacology, within the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences. This course bears 2 undergraduate credits and is co-taught to expose students to a variety of teaching styles and expertise.

The program will feature a number of off-campus excursions focusing on many of the most famous historical and cultural sites in NYC. These excursions will be led by Student Ambassadors, who are specially trained SJU students. In addition to being warm and friendly guides to the city, they also provide an opportunity for program participants to practice their English outside of the classroom, in everyday, authentic situations.

Students will also have the opportunity to tour the city in smaller groups, organized with a student Adventure Leader who will take participants to venues that are "off the beaten path."

In addition, two professional walking tours of will be provided. Examples of possible tours are Central Park and Greenwich Village.

Travel to and from excursions will be via NYC's famed subway, giving participants a sense of how best to navigate the city during independent excursions as well.







Housing and Meals

Students are safely housed in St. John's University dormitories oncampus. Linens and cleaning services are provided. There is WiFi access throughout campus.

Students will be given Dining Dollars to spend in on-campus food service locations for breakfast and lunch, and they will be free to purchase dinner where they would like—whether that is a hot dog cart in Central Park, a Chinese restaurant in Flushing, or a good old American steakhouse in Brooklyn. In New York City, the possibilities are endless!

The St. John's University Queens campus provides access to Computer and Printing Facilities, our Library and a Fitness Center.

Laundry facilities are also available on campus.
